MAKE ARRANGEMENTS FOR CHILDCARE

We love families and children! However, the convention is geared for parent/teacher enrichment and we recommend that parents find childcare for younger children.

BRING YOUR SPOUSE

It's important to be of "one mind" in your education decisions. A husband and wife attending the convention together is a great way to develop and solidify vision for your family's homeschool journey.

BRING A SWEATER OR JACKET

The air conditioning can make the Convention Center a bit chilly at times.

BRING A NOTEBOOK

For taking notes in workshops or jotting down ideas.

PLAN MEALS AND SNACKS

The Phoenix Convention Center does not allow outside food or beverages to be brought into the facility. In addition to the on-site concessions run by the Convention Center, there are a number of restaurants and fast food locations within walking distance.

WEAR COMFORTABLE SHOES

You'll probably be doing a lot of walking and standing on a concrete floor especially if you're planning to spend time in the exhibit hall.

BRING A BACKPACK OR SMALL, WHEELED CART/SUITCASE

Helpful for carrying your purchases and any catalogs or brochures you collect along the way.

BRING YOUR NAME BADGES

For those who pre-register by the early registration deadline, name badges are mailed to you. Name badges will serve as your admission to the convention and must be worn at all times.
